Abstract Submission Guidelines

Prospective authors are invited to submit original and unpublished abstracts aligned with the conference theme "Tasawwuf, Social Harmony and World Peace" and its sub-themes. Submissions must comply with the following guidelines:

Key Deadlines:

Abstract submissions open: 1 April 2026

Deadline for abstracts (250–300 words): 30 June 2026

Notification of acceptance: 15 July 2026

Full paper submission: 30 September 2026

Final Selection Notification: 01 November 2026 - 15 November 2026

Conference Dates: 9 - 11 December 2026

Language Policy

Abstract must be submitted in English, Bengali, Arabic, Persian or Urdu.

However, full papers and presentations may be delivered in Bengali, English, Arabic, or Urdu.

Abstract Requirements

Word limit: 250–300 words

The abstract should clearly include:

- Methodology Research objective(s).
- Methodology or approach.
- Key arguments/findings.
- Significance of the study.

Include 5-6 keywords at the end of the abstract.

Line spacing: 1.5

Text alignment: Justified

Title: Bold, 14 pt, centered

Do not include references, citations or footnotes in the abstract.

Email submissions will not be accepted unless officially requested.

Review Process

All abstracts will undergo a double-blind peer review process.

Evaluation criteria include:

- Relevance to the conference theme
- Originality and academic merit
- Clarity and coherence

Authors will be notified within the specified timeline.

Important Notes

Submissions must be original and not under review elsewhere. Multiple abstract submissions are allowed; however, only one paper may be selected for presentation per author.

Accepted authors must submit the full paper within the deadline. Selected papers may be considered for publication in conference proceedings or partner journals.
